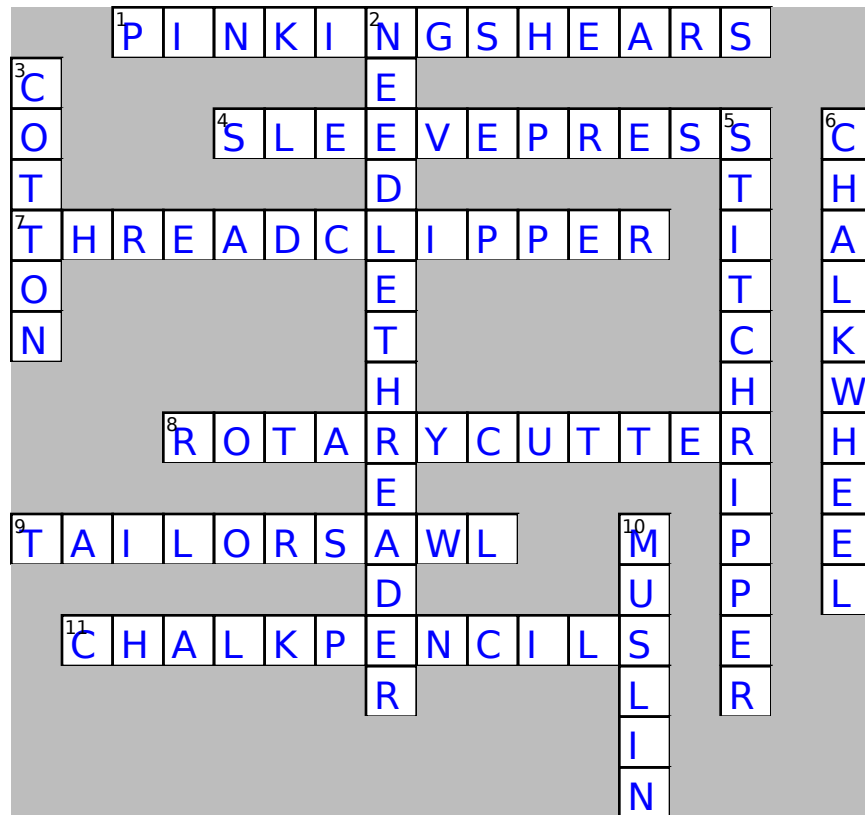


# Sewing Equipment

| <p>1 Across</p> <p>1 These scissors cut zigzag, fray resistant edges. They are excellent for finishing seams and raw edges (2 Words)</p> <p>4 Looks like a tiny ironing board (2 Words)</p> <p>7 A small tool for cutting loose threads, making buttonholes or ripping seams out (2 Words)</p> <p>8 Not a substitute for a Pizza Cutter! (2 Words)</p> <p>9 This is a sharp, pointed tool used to make round holes used for eyelets and keyhole buttonholes (2 Words)</p> <p>11 Favoured by quilters, these pencils make thin and accurate lines which wash out after marking (2 Words)</p> | <p>Down</p> <p>2 The wire loop on this tiny tool is inserted into the eye of the needle. (2 Words)</p> <p>3 This type of thread is used to achieve a "puckered" look</p> <p>5 The sharp, curved edge makes it easy to open seams (2 Words)</p> <p>6 Filled with loose chalk dust (2 Words)</p> <p>10 An inexpensive medium weight used to test the fit of a pattern or practice a technique</p> |
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
